Team Overviews



The EWB UBC Chapter drives education, sustainability, and wellness initiatives in Vancouver, transforming community discussions into impactful actions. Our chapter offers leadership opportunities and a supportive space for meaningful conversations through our **four** ventures: **Engi-YOU Wellness**, which promotes student health and wellness; **Youth Venture**, which bridges educational gaps by providing practical, real-world experiences for high school students; **Aquafier**, focused on raising awareness about the adverse consequences of unsafe drinking water in Canada and providing a solution through the creation of a water filtration system; and **ACCESS Venture**, developing accessible HPV screening technologies to address high cervical cancer rates in sub-Saharan Africa.

Venture Projects

AQUAFIER

Aquafier is a new project to raise awareness about the adverse consequences of unsafe drinking water in Canada and provide a solution through the creation of a water filtration system. Currently, Aquafier is looking for stakeholders to collaborate with, which will shape the design of their filtration system. Additionally, this team will be preparing to attend the Canadian National Water Treatment Competition to gain further insights and skills in water treatment. Aquafier aims to engineer a world where everyone has access to clean, safe drinking water.

YOUTH VENTURE

ACCESS

ACCESS, which stands for Advancing Cervical Cancer Education and Screening in Sub-Saharan Africa, is dedicated to tackling the pressing public health issue of cervical cancer in sub-Saharan Africa, where the prevalence of this disease is highest, by creating an HPV self-testing kit. We believe that resourceful engineering solutions and community engagement come hand in hand in improving accessibility to cervical cancer screening technologies, ultimately contributing to the reduction of cervical cancer incidence and mortality rates.

General Meetings

The EWB UBC Chapter hosts **four club-wide general meetings each year**. These meetings provide ventures with a platform to share project updates, and members have the opportunity to collaborate with other ventures during the social segment. One of these general meetings includes a **professional development session**, featuring a panel discussion where industry professionals answer questions from EWB members.

Team Socials

This year, one of the EWB UBC Chapter's goals is to foster greater transparency and collaboration between ventures. To support this, we aim to introduce **at least two organization-wide socials**, providing opportunities for members to build stronger inter-venture connections and enhance teamwork across the chapter.

Volunteering

The EWB UBC Chapter values **camaraderie and teamwork**, both professionally and recreationally. This year, we've launched a volunteering goal, where members are encouraged to collaborate across ventures to support our chapter and the community. To recognize their efforts, individual and team prizes will be awarded to the most dedicated participants.

xChange Conference

xChange is an annual multi-day conference hosted by EWB Canada, convening our network of socially engaged engineers. xChange brings together leaders, innovators, and change makers from various fields to collaborate, inspire, and drive positive impact.

In Fall 2024, through three dynamic xChange events in Toronto, Montreal, and Vancouver, over 500 students and professionals dove deep into pressing questions, examining how engineering and technology are essential to driving meaningful change for Canada and the world.

In January 2026 our community, our alumni and our partners will gather in Toronto for xChange 2026: Bridging the Past, Building the Future: Engineering Systemic Change. EWB Canada will celebrate its 25 year legacy and bring together a diverse group of delegates to dive into the root causes of systemic issues and define solutions.

Anchored around three core pillars, Leadership, Community, and Impact & Innovation, the conference will offer participants opportunities for deep reflection, skill-building, and connection. Leadership-focused sessions will empower attendees to grow in their capacity to lead in the social impact space. Community programming will emphasize inclusive, equitable relationship-building within EWB and beyond. Speakers and panel presentations will explore pressing global challenges and how engineering and technology can drive tangible, systemic solutions.

Through keynote addresses, workshops, and storytelling from across the EWB network, xChange 2026 will bring together members, chapter alumni, young professionals, and industry leaders. This unique gathering will strengthen our shared commitment to social change and celebrate the collective momentum we are building toward a brighter, more sustainable future.
